Dear Potential Sponsor,

We are the University of Nebraska Dance Marathon, and we are this generation fighting for the next. Approximately 62 children each minute will need treatment for life-threatening illness. In total, there will be 32 million patient visits for over 10 million kids every year, and it's our time to take action. Dance Marathon is an organization that raises money to support research and training, purchase equipment and pay for uncompensated care at Children's Miracle Network Hospitals. We do this all in support of the mission to save and improve the lives of as many children as possible. The fire behind the Dance Marathon movement includes over 400 Dance Marathon programs across North America, 200,000 student dancers, and 1 million participants that led to over 44 million dollars raised for Children's Hospital in 2019, and over 34 million in 2020 despite the COVID-19 pandemic.

At the University of Nebraska, we are approaching our 19th annual Dance Marathon. Since our inception, 100% of the money we have raised has gone towards the Children's Hospital & Medical Center, with over \$224,000 being donated in 2020. This year we are looking to grow our event and break our fundraising goal of \$252,000. This year, we are excited to be able to focus our fundraising efforts on an operating room and supporting the Rainbow House, which is a program that allows out of state families to stay without the burden of payment.

Unfortunately, we cannot do this alone. We would love to have your help in attaining this goal and giving each child the childhood they deserve. Your sponsorship is crucial in helping cover some of the operating costs of our various events throughout the year to ensure that the most money can be donated to the hospital. 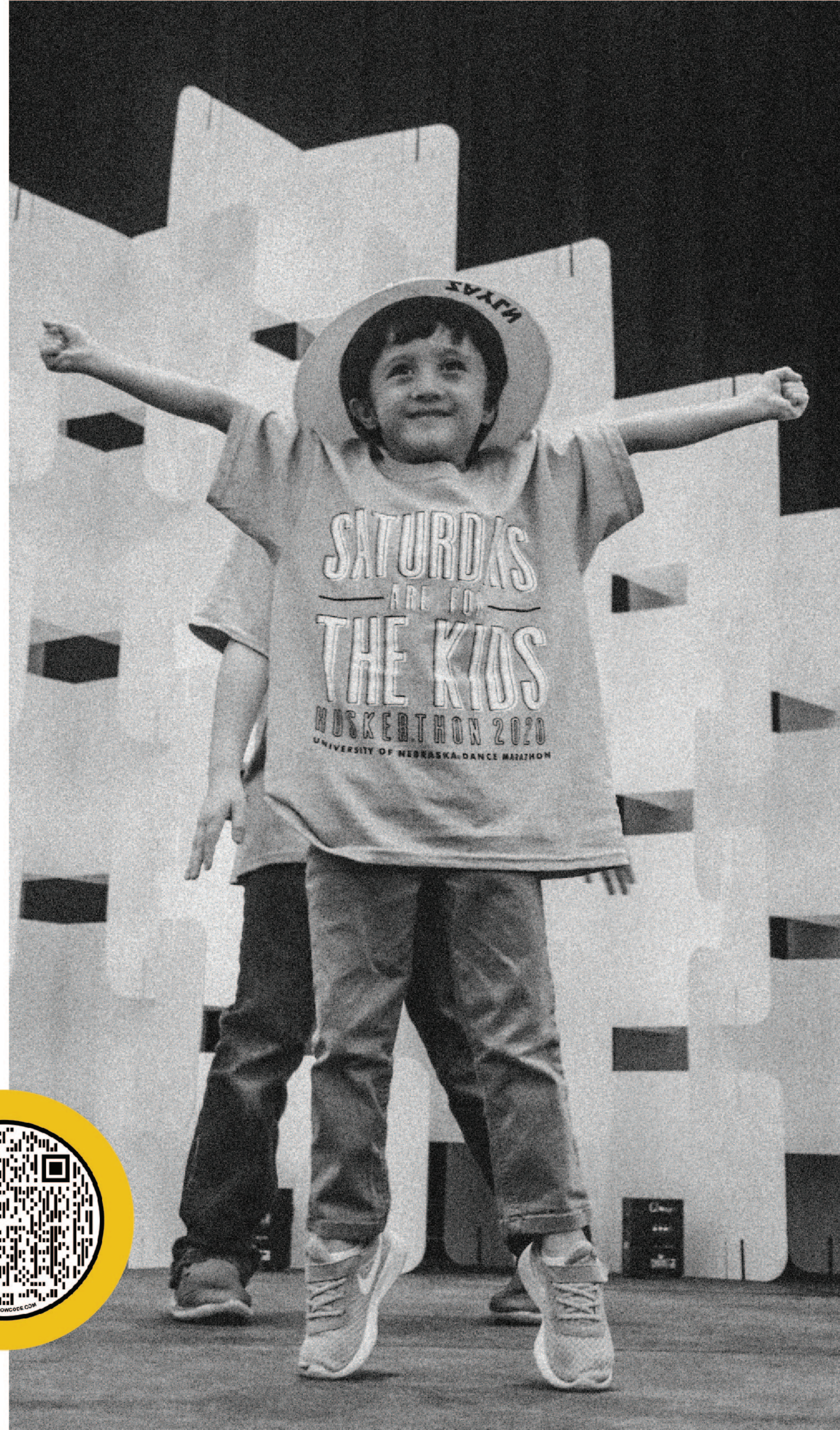

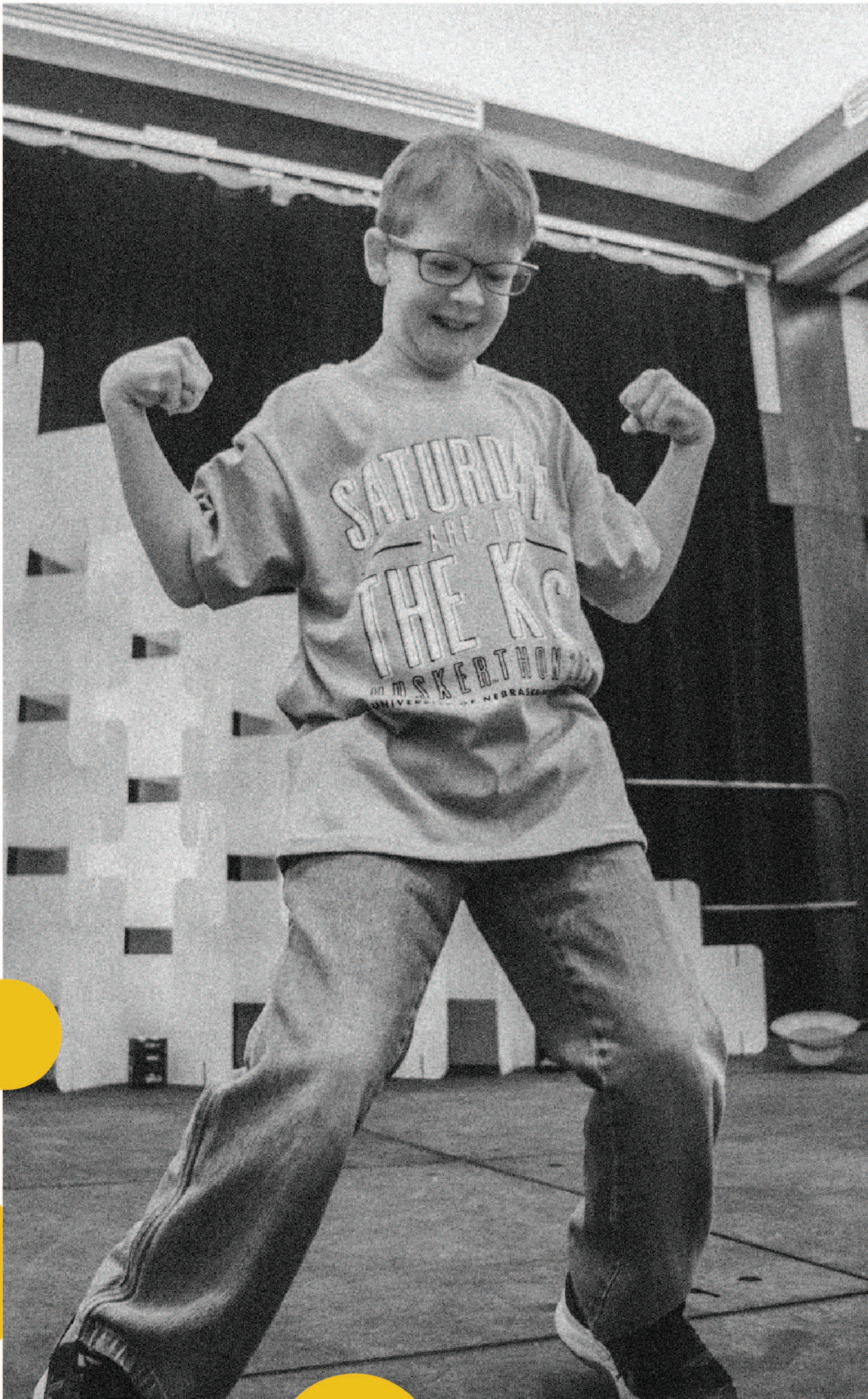

Letter from Miracle Family



Malcolm is our miracle child. He was diagnosed in 2013 with stage 4 neuroblastoma, leaving him with only a 10% chance at living. Our family's world was turned upside down. For the next year, we tried everything possible to help Malcolm's body be free of the cancer – chemotherapy, radiation, surgery, and clinical trials for new treatments. With none of these treatments achieving the goal of remission, we had one last option – a clinical trial in NYC for an unproven immunotherapy that would be painful for Malcolm to receive. By the grace of God, it was effective and Malcolm is now 6 years off treatment and no evidence of disease! Life "after" cancer is still a challenge for Malcolm as he deals with the after-effects of the treatments employed to save his life, such as physical and cognitive limitations.

UNDM is one of those organizations that makes the world for a miracle child so much brighter. Malcolm knows that the young women and men of UNDM care for him and his family unconditionally, as demonstrated by their compassionate attitudes and actions in raising funds for the children, specifically for Omaha Children's Hospital. UNDM also has meant the world for Malcolm's 7 siblings! These kids also had their world turned upside down with Malcolm's cancer, often wondering if their brother would survive, being unsure of where their parents were while they cared for Malcolm, and having their lives be subsumed by the needs of their brother. The members of UNDM have wrapped their arms around our entire family, literally, to make us feel loved and cared for. Knowing that the University of Nebraska-Lincoln had a Dance Marathon organization was critical for us deciding to move to Lincoln 4 years ago.

I would strongly encourage any individual or organization open to sponsoring UNDM to do so. Your support and funds could not be devoted to a more worthy cause – that of helping young women and men bless the lives of kids (and their families) who are or have suffered through traumatic medical events. There is nothing more admirable than helping the helpless, and the miracle kiddos that UNDM supports definitely qualify as such.

Children's Hospital & Medical Center in Omaha, NE, is a 145-bed, nonprofit organization that has been caring for children since 1948. It is the only full-service, pediatric healthcare center in Nebraska, providing expertise in more than 50 pediatric specialty services. Patients are referred from throughout the region for the treatment of complex or rare diseases. In addition to pediatric primary care, at Children's, no child in need of medical care is ever turned away due to financial status.

Children's Hospital & Medical Center's mission "to improve the life of every child" is at the heart of everything they do. As the region's leader in pediatric healthcare, Children's Hospital is dedicated to exceptional clinical care, research, education, and advocacy. Whether they're providing care for critically ill children or championing child-centered legislation, Children's Hospital strives to improve the lives of youth, families, and entire communities.

In 2020, despite the pandemic, UNDM was able to continue to set fundraising records. Using the money we raised this past year alone we were able to sponsor five CARES (Children's Ambulatory Recover and Express Services) unit patient rooms, a Radiology room, and an Ultrasound room. This year we hope to continue our success and are focusing our fundraising efforts on an operating room with a cost of \$250,000 and supporting the Rainbow House, which is a program that allows out of state families to stay without the burden of payment.



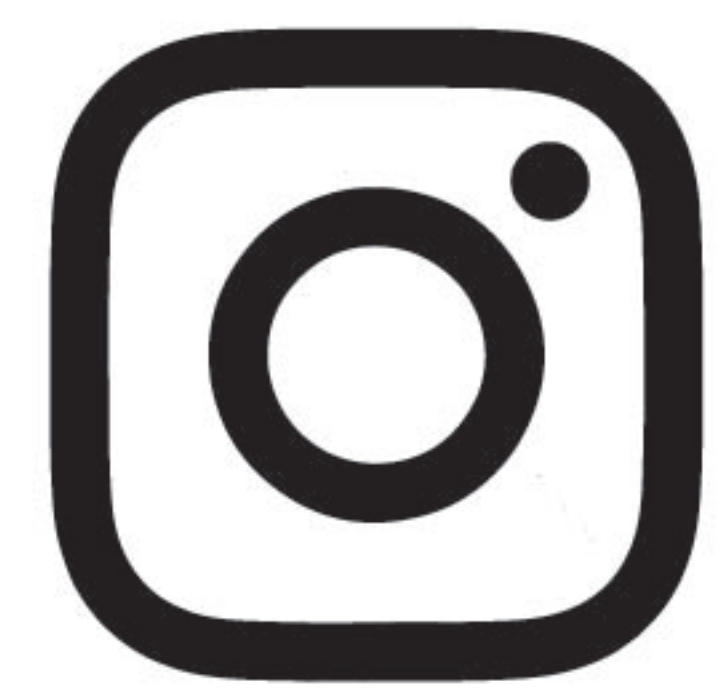

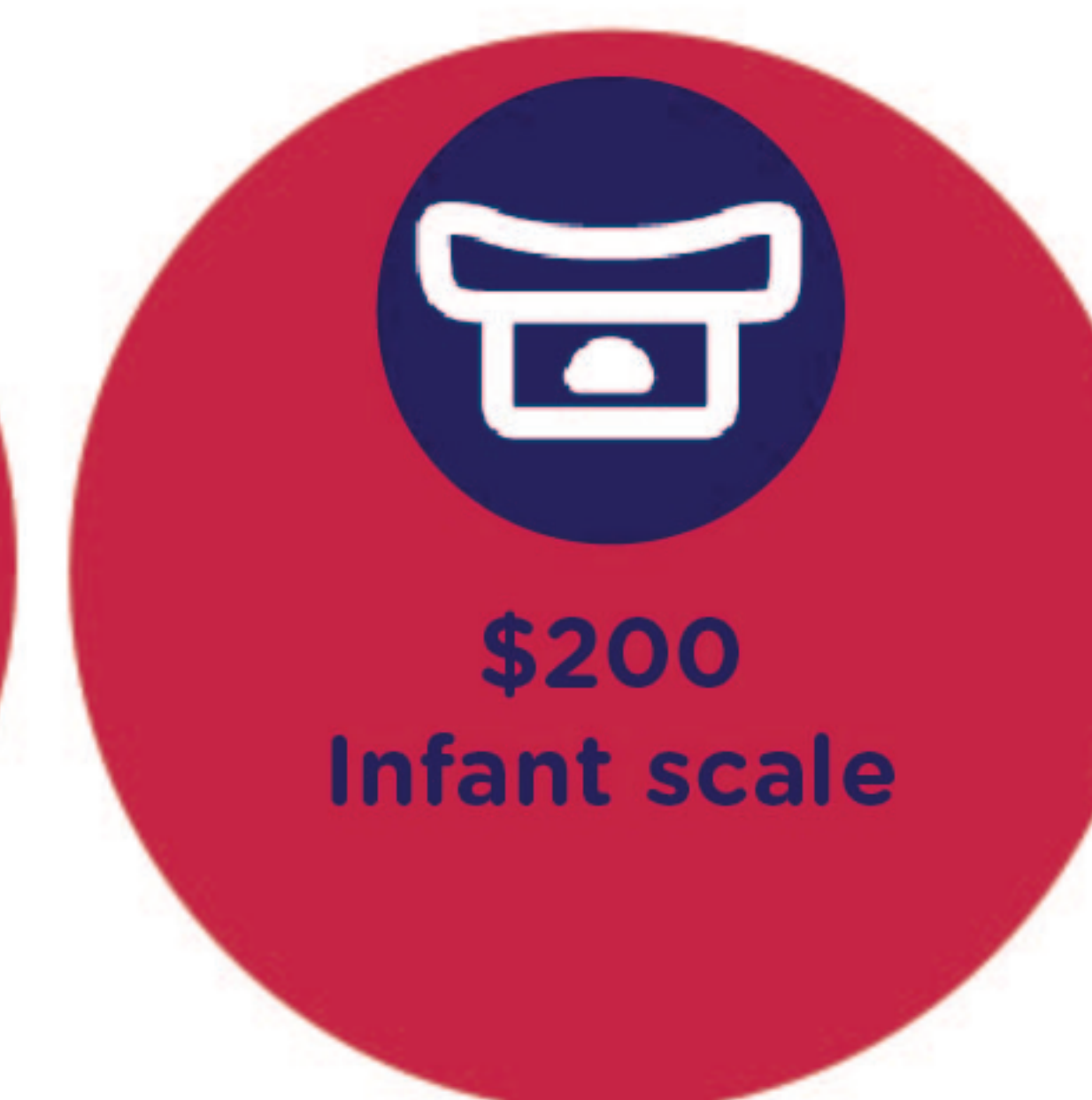
